She took her grandmother's lemonade recipe and added honey to it, she proceeded to sell her BeeSweet Lemonade and donated all the profits to organisations that save endangered species, particularly honeybees.

Mikaila also went on to the famous 'Shark Tank' and received US\$60 000 in investments toward her business. By 2016 at the age of 12 she was already a millionaire with mega market 'Whole Foods' picking up her lemonade for US\$11 million.
